Hostel Fee Explanation

a) Hostel Fee Calculation

- The Themba Trust charges Annual Hostel fees of 20 764.00 for 2012.
- These are payable in four parts before the beginning of each term. The amount payable per term is R5191.00
- If you pay upfront for the whole year, you qualify for a discount. You then only pay the amount of R18688.00.
- Hostel Fees must be paid electronically into the relevant Bank Account, as indicated below:

- Please ensure that you always make the payments BEFORE your child returns to Themba at the beginning of a new term. If fees are not paid up front, we regrettably cannot admit or readmit your child to the hostel.

b) Once-Off Hostel Registration Fee for new learners

All new learners are requested to pay a once-off registration fee of R1980 to help cover the costs of ongoing upgrading and renovations of the hostel, improved security measures, use of washing machines and the following items for each learner's use:

- A new mattress
- A Duvet & Pillow
- 2 sets of bed linen (sheet, duvet cover & pillow case)
- 1 set of cutlery (knife, fork, spoon, teaspoon)
- 1 set of crockery (large plate, side plate, soup/cereal bowl, cup)

This fee is requested in order to ensure that learners all have the same basic items for use, so that there is no jealousy among learners.

Note: If your child is removed from the Themba Residential Education Centre, she or he will be able to take along the above personal items, including the mattress, duvet and pillow and bed linen set, cutlery and crockery, provided she or he has looked after it properly.
